

Escape Room Information

Thank you for signing up for Cokato Museum's *A Haunted History*.

Now that you are planning on playing there are a few things you need to know before you do!

1. You and each of your group members will need to sign a waiver before participating in the Escape Room. Minors will need their parent or guardian to sign the waiver as well. Feel free to ask for the waiver before you arrive to the game to look it over at home.
2. Your group will need to put down a \$20 cash deposit which will be refunded to you after the Escape Room game is over. The deposit will be kept if there are any damages that occurred by the participants to props in the game or if an artifact is handled.
3. At no point during the game should an artifact be handled. If you touch an artifact you will be warned once. A second offense results in the game ending and a loss of your deposit.
4. If an artifact is damaged in the museum the person who caused the damage will accept full financial responsibility. The game will also end.
5. Participants will not be allowed to play if they arrive intoxicated or under the influence of drugs. You will need all of your brain power to solve the puzzles.
6. A group of minors will need to be accompanied by an adult of the age 21 or older.
7. Please arrive on time! The museum door will be locked at your start time. No participants who are late will be allowed in. If the entire group is late you will have to reschedule.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is an Escape Room?

Essentially it is a game where a group of people get put in a room (in this case the museum) and have to solve a series of puzzles and complete the objective before time is up.

2. How many people can play?

We recommend groups of 4-8 people for the optimal good time. We will not take more than a group of eight or less than a group of four. (Any more than eight and there will not be enough for everyone to do and less than four there won't be enough people to enable you to solve the puzzles in time.)

3. How long will it take?

About an hour and fifteen minutes total. Players will be playing the game for 45 minutes, however they will need to receive instruction before they enter the room and will be debriefed after the game is over.

4. How much does it cost?

The event is free! Donations are appreciated. A refundable \$20 cash or check only damage deposit required.

5. What happens if we achieve the objective before time is up?

You WIN! If you approve, a photograph will be added to the We Made History wall! See if you can usurp the champions!

6. What happens if we do not solve all of the puzzles in time?

You are HISTORY!!! Just kidding. We will let you out and you will be debriefed. You are encouraged to let us take a fun picture of your group and hang it on our We Are History wall!

7. What if I need to go to the bathroom?

We recommend you go before you come but there are restrooms in the game room. However, time will not be stopped while you go.

8. What if I need to get out if there is an Emergency?

There are two Emergency Exits that can be used.

9. Can I bring my kids?

You may bring your children but they must have an adult of 21 or older supervising. It is family friendly but kids over the age of 12 will probably be able to participate in solving the puzzles more.

10. Can I play more than once?

Yes, please inform us ahead of time and we can modify the game so not all of the puzzles will be exactly the same. If you want the same puzzles as last time please let us know.

11. Can I Google answers?

No cell phones or tools you brought in can be used during the game. Cell phones will be kept in the museum office unless needed for emergency purposes.
