In honor of Halloween, we will be hosting a short-term Escape Room (our third) beginning Saturday, October 7th and running through Saturday, November 4th. As in many Halloween tales of old, the plot unfolds something like this...

It was a dark and stormy night...or something like that...you and a group of friends are on your way home from a Halloween party and notice that the doors of the Cokato Museum are wide open. Your group goes in to see if anything is amiss. Not finding anyone, you venture further and the Halloween exhibit catches your eye. Suddenly at 11:55, the doors swing shut and your group is LOCKED IN! Now you must figure out in an hour who locked you in and how you are going to escape! Beware, at Midnight, some of Cokato's history comes to life...

No prior knowledge of Cokato's history is needed to play. The event is free but groups will be required to provide a \$20 refundable damage deposit. Groups consist of 4-8 people ranging in ages from 12-adult. Minors will need to be accompanied by an adult aged 21 or older.

Preregistration at least four days in advance is required. (We are a full functioning museum and a staff of two so we need a little time to plan.) Hours for the event are regular museum hours Tuesday through Friday from 9 a.m.-4:30 p.m., and Saturday from 9 a.m.-3 p.m. (Please note: Saturdays will provide a more interactive experience as there are more volunteers working that day. Also, hours will vary depending on staff availability, museum needs, and holidays.)
